

RULES FOR CAMPERS & WORKERS

We are happy you are planning to attend camp this year and it is our prayer you will receive many blessings and enjoy participating in all the activities. Bring your friends, meet new ones and join us in bringing honor and glory to our Lord Jesus Christ.

This is a list of guidelines set by the camp and the host church. We ask that you read these carefully and we expect each of you to abide by these rules.

1. Take care and show respect for this campground and surrounding area.
2. Speak with language that is not offensive to others. Honor God and respect others in your speech.
3. Be aware of the extreme fire dangers and leave matches and other flammables at home! No fireworks!
4. Do not bring radios, TV's, personal stereos, CD players, Ipods, Cell phones, Text messaging phones, game players, etc. (You get the idea, if it isn't mentioned, you know!)
5. Do not bring alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs. If you have either one of these you will be sent home immediately. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
6. Do not bring cigarettes or tobacco products. They will be confiscated and if seen again you will be sent home. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
7. Do not bring firearms, slingshots, knives, etc! DUH!
8. NO bare midriffs! NO crop tops. Shorts must be mid-thigh. Shirts must be worn unless you are swimming.
9. Tank tops will not be allowed in the dining hall during meals.
10. Neither tank tops nor shorts will be permitted in church services.
11. Respect the rights of others and be friendly to everyone.
12. Do not keep candy and sodas in the rooms. There is a big ant problem at camp.
13. Always feel free to talk with your counselor, teacher, camp director or any other adult at camp. We are here to help with any problem — physical, emotional or spiritual.

Just ask yourself; "Would I do this or say this if Jesus were here beside me? He is, you know. We pray that no serious problems arise; however, if one does the rules will be enforced.
